





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1. STES AT A GLANCE

Sinhgad Technical Education Society, also referred to as STES, is a collection of education institutes operating mainly in the region of Pune, India. It provides education in various fields like Engineering, Management, Pharmacy, Architecture, and Computer Applications.

STES was founded by Prof. M. N. Navale in 1993 in response to the increasing education criteria in rapidly growing industry after the Open business strategy policy of Indian government.

STES was set up in August 1993 by Prof. M. N. Navale. It began with the formation of Sou. Venutai Chavan Polytechnic Institute in the field of Engineering, offering 3-year full-time Diploma courses in Engineering, recognized by the Government of Maharashtra and approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi. From then, STES has been continually expanding.

In 1994-95, the Post-Graduation MBA course of Pune University was started with just 90 students. And today, there are 180 students taking benefit of this course.

In 1996-97, the Engineering College was established by STES, offering 4-year full-time Degree courses in the fields of Mechanical, Production, Chemical, Civil, Information Technology, Computer Engineering and Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering. The college is affiliated to the Pune University. In the same year, a 3-year full-time Masters in Computer Applications (MCA) course was started. 60 students are currently admitted to this course.

STES has also started the Sinhgad Spring Dale School, a Residential Public School and Regular Day School (English Medium) from June 2000, running pre-primary, primary and secondary school.

In 2000-2001, the Smt. Kashibai Navale College of Engineering was started for girls. It conducts Degree courses in the fields of Information Technology, Computer Engineering and Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering. But from academic year 2006-07, the college was also made open for boys. In the same year mechanical branch is also introduced.

In 2000-2001 year, Sinhgad College of Architecture and Sinhgad College of Pharmacy were started. The College of Architecture conducts a 5-year Degree course (B. Arch) with 40 students and the College of Pharmacy conducts a 4-year Degree course (B. Pharm.) with 60 students.

Sinhgad college of Science was started in year 2000-01 with B.Sc. (Computer Science) with intake of 80 students.

In 2004-2005, the Sinhgad Institute of Management and Computer Application (SIMCA) started the 2-year full-time Masters of Business Administration (MBA) and 2-year full-time Masters of Computer Application (MCA) courses with intake 60 each.

In 2008-2009, Sinhgad Institute of Technology & Science was started at Narhe Campus. The institute is the fifth from STES offering Degree courses in Engineering. Courses in the fields of Information Technology, Computer Science Engineering, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering and Mechanical Engineering are offered. But from academic year 2010-11, the Civil Engineering branch was introduced.

Overview

The placement activity is primarily managed by the Placement Committee headed by the Director of the institute as Chairperson. The placement process for the graduating batch of the MBA program at SIMCA started in the month of August 2021. There were 240 students from the batch 2020-22, those who were interested in campus placements. Details of the students are given in the report. Total 550 companies visited for campus placements. The details of some of these companies are also given in the report. Total 96 students are placed through campus placements. Details of the placed students are shared in the following report.

Placement Policy

The role of the Training and Placement Cell is of a facilitator and councilor for placement related activities.

The placement facility is available to all the students registered with Training & Placement Cell.

It is mandatory for the students to attend aptitude and other trainings (Resume Writing/Email Writing/GD/PI) failing to which students will not be allowed to participate in any Training & Placement Activity.

College uniform is mandatory for students to be present in the Campus Recruitment Programme, failing which students will not be allowed to appear for campus interview.

Students must keep their Identity Card with them at the time of PPT/Test/Group Discussion/ Interviews, and produce the same when demanded by the visiting team or their representatives. For pre-placement talks (PPT) students should be present at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time at the venue & be seated. Delay in reporting will disqualify the student from recruitment process. Students should be punctual & once the HR People/Company representative enters the venue all doors will be closed and NO ENTRY to the students.

Canvassing with the Company Personnel will disqualify the candidature of the student. If students face any difficulty or have any queries, they should contact the member of T&P cell only. Students should not contact the recruiter directly. This should be strictly followed.

Any student who has received offer letter, must inform the Placement office and submit the photocopy of the same as soon as possible.


Students should fill their information in the shared google data sheet to participate in Campus Recruitment Programmes. Also students need to check their information regularly and update the same whenever required. As this information will be shared with the industries. If any student fails to fill or update the information he/she may miss the opportunity to participate in the campus recruitment drives.

Decorum should be maintained by the students during the Placements/Recruitment programme. Any behavior bringing disgrace to the Institute will not be tolerated and strict action will be taken against such students. Students should follow professional etiquette. If found guilty, such students will be disqualified from further placement activity.

Any breach of these rules shall lead to the student getting debarred from the placement process. During the Campus Recruitment Programme, a student who registers for a company should mandatorily appear for the Campus selection process, failing which he/she will be debarred from the Campus Recruitment Programme for all other subsequent companies. Students should have positive approach towards placement drives.

Those students, who do not wish to participate for any recruitment process, must inform the T&P office in advance, so as to give opportunity to the other students.

If market situation and Job scenario necessitates a revision in the Placement Policy, it will be done in a manner so as to maximize the benefit to the student community as a whole.

She shared her research work and talked about her experience in all these years. She gave several examples of prototyping. She also explains how prototyping is used in various fields like Engineering, Architecture, etc.




She presented her work and observations in tourism growth in social, political, economic sectors. Also emphasized on how to use social media platforms for encouraging women and many more.




Activity Background -





- How do you market your business?




